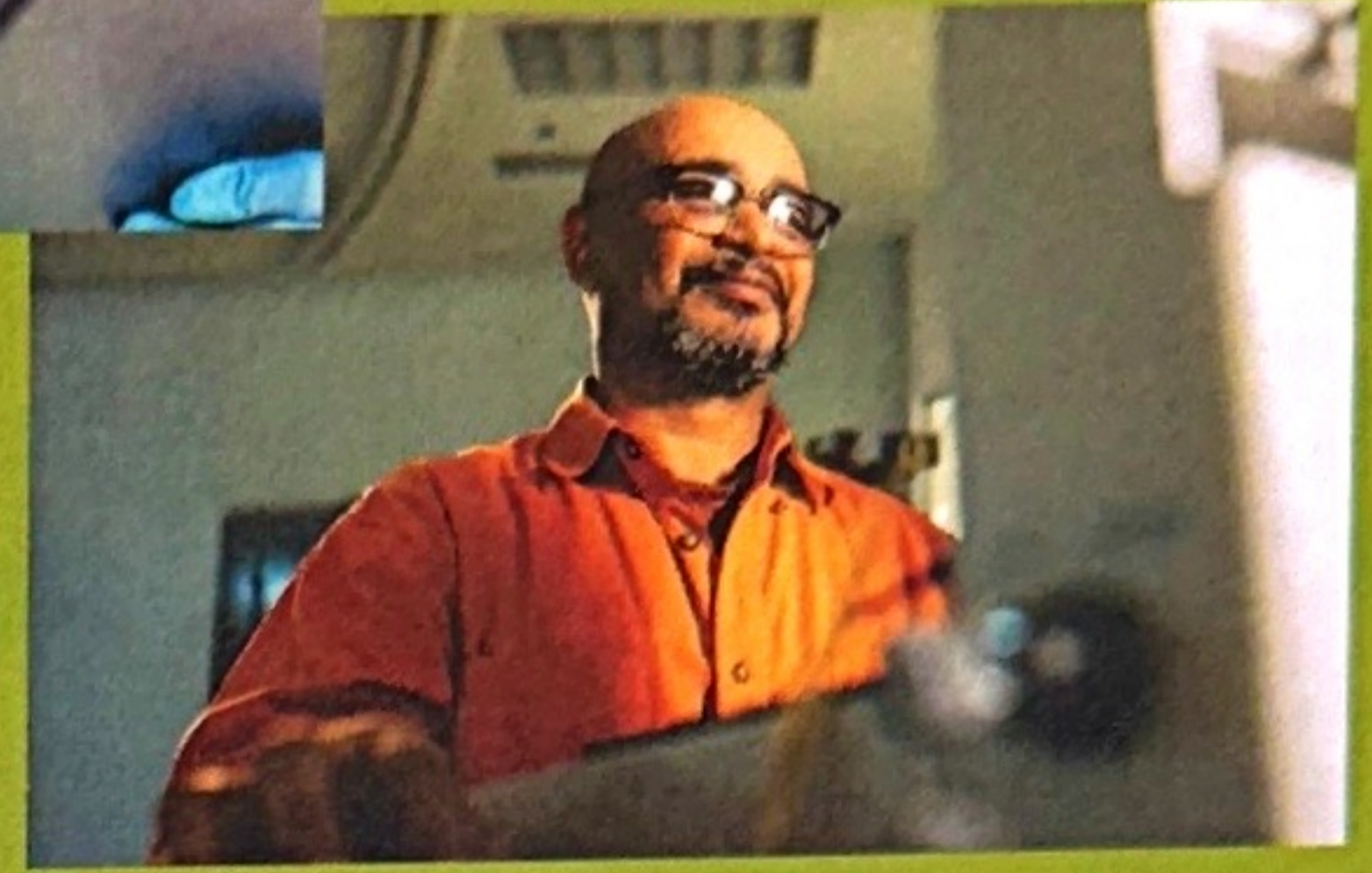
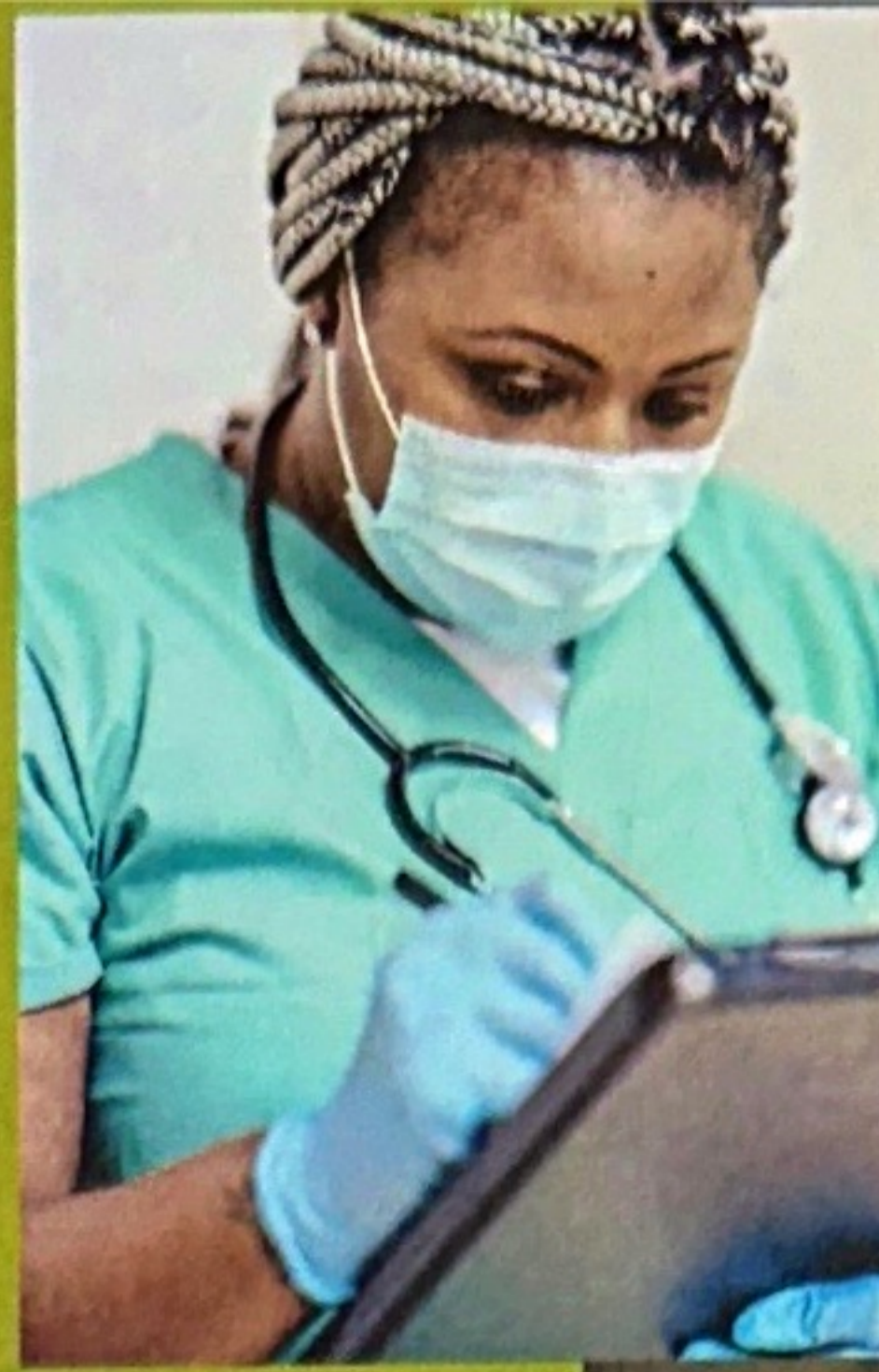


Lifelong Learning Accounts at isles

Up to \$9600 for training, education and support

Grants are available through the **Financial Opportunity Center** at Isles. Eligible unemployed/underemployed NJ residents receive funding to pay for training, education, and additional supports while earning credentials and securing employment.



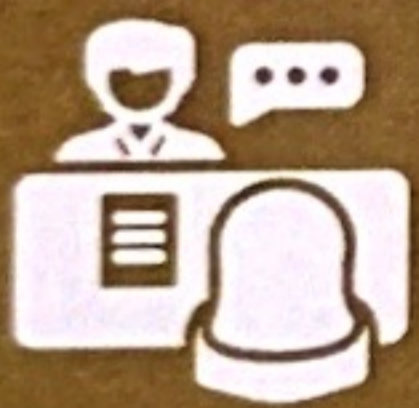
Employment Coaching

Meet with an employment coach to discuss your goals, skills, and interests. Access ongoing one-on-one support as you pursue training and employment.



Earn a degree or credential

Find out about education and training opportunities to qualify for in-demand jobs. Use grant funding to pay for education or training.



Resume writing and interview skills

Increase your chances of landing a new job, with a polished resume and improved interview skills.



Use of grant funds

In addition to the direct costs of education/training, Lifelong Learning Account funds of up to \$9600 can be used for childcare, transportation and other means of support as you obtain new skills and secure employment.



Who is eligible?

Employment coaching and job readiness services are available to all. LiLA Accounts are available to income-eligible NJ residents over 18, pursuing training for in-demand jobs and utilizing the services of this program. Must be unemployed/underemployed for the past 6 months. *Contact Isles for full details.*
